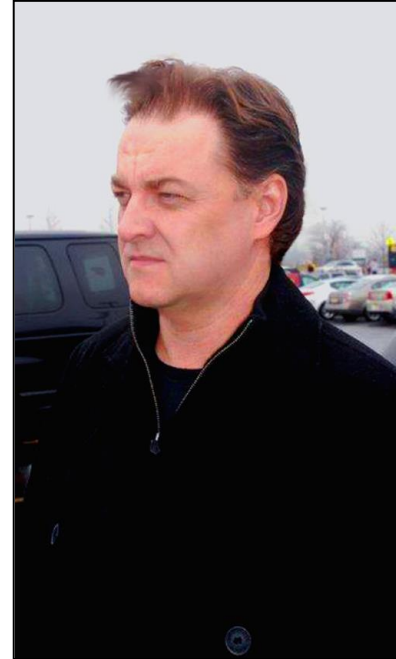


Why talk to Wil Mara?

- **Unquestionably one of the foremost authorities on the ‘Babushka Lady’**—an unidentified female (clad in a head scarf, hence the nickname) who was standing about 30 feet from President Kennedy’s limousine when he was struck, and who may have taken either still photos or motion pictures of the assassination. Most assassination experts believe her film, since shot from a unique angle as well as a much closer proximity than that of the famous ‘Zapruder film,’ would likely resolve many remaining questions about the tragedy (e.g., whether or not there was a second shooter either on the ‘grassy knoll’ or behind the picket fence).
- **Conducted extensive research during the writing of *Frame 232* that stretched over 10 years** and included reading more than 50 books (including the *full* version of the ‘Warren Report’) and over 200 articles on the Kennedy assassination, traveling to Dealey Plaza and related sites in the Dallas area, and having firsthand conversations and various correspondence with other assassination experts as well as surviving witnesses and other participants.
